# ISLAND VEHICLE DECLARATION

Article 3 of the Road Vehicles (Registration & Licensing) (Amendment Regulations 1992 provides that a licensing authority must be satisfied that a vehicle is correctly taxed. In this regard, this declaration should be completed by each owner to declare their island address. Documentary evidence may be requested.

Section 4(f) the Motor Vehicle (Duties and Licences) Act 2004 defines Island Vehicles as “vehicles which are kept and used exclusively on an offshore island to which there is no direct road or bridge access from the mainland”
