## FIRE SAFETY ADVICE Working/Studying at Home

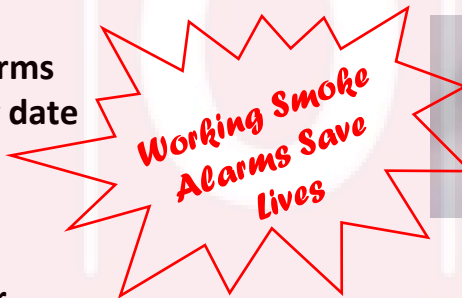
### Electrical Devices

- ✓ Use only CE marked & undamaged chargers
- ✗ Do not overload sockets
- ✗ Do not leave devices charging overnight
- ✗ Do not charge on combustible surfaces, e.g. beds, sofas



### Smoke Alarms

- ✓ Have sufficient working smoke alarms
- ✓ Test them regularly & check expiry date
- ✗ Never remove the batteries



### Stoves & Open Fires

- ✓ Engage a competent stove installer
- ✓ Clean your chimney/flue regularly
- ✓ Use a spark-guard when unattended



### Candles

- ✗ Never leave unattended or lighting overnight
- ✓ Use proper holders on a heat resistant surface
- ✓ Keep away from combustible items

### Night time routine

- ✓ Switch off all unnecessary appliances
- ✓ Close doors to reduce fire spread – 'Close Before You Doze'
- ✓ Keep exit door keys close at hand



### Have an Escape Plan

- ✓ Plan your escape routes
- ✓ Designate a meeting point outside
- ✓ Crawl along the floor if there's smoke present

### In the event of fire...

- ✓ Ring 999/112
- ✓ Know your Eircode
- ✓ Get out. Stay out. Get the Fire Brigade Out.
