



**Local Government (Charges) Act 2009
Cork County Council**

The N.P.P.R. (Non-Principal Private Residence) charge is a tax payable on all on Non-Principal Private Residences situated in the State (Republic of Ireland).

MOBILE HOME

A mobile home which is not the principal private residence of the owner is exempt from the charge.

A mobile home is a home that is constructed at a location remote from the place of its intended use- to that extent it must be 'mobile' for it to be transported to where it is to be located. It is therefore prefabricated and can be moved again.
