SITE TBM = 115.285m OD MALIN HEAD (INDICATED WITH STEEL NAIL & WASHER)

Wall height to match wall height of adjacent wall, finish to be plastered and capped

Existing hedge row and existing embankment / ground level to be reduced to new formation level, lay new 1500mm wide concrete footpath and make good to existing, shown shaded in green

4 extra road side parking spaces shown in red

Edge of existing road

Existing tree line hedge row to be removed, existing ground level to be reduced to new formation level, lay new 1800mm wide concrete footpath and make good to existing.

New Security fencing systems 1.8m high V-mesh panel system for the total length of the new footpath

Existing entrance gates to be relocated to the inside line of the proposed new footpath and make good

New off road Childrens pick up area 10m x 8m, Existing ground level to be reduced to new formation level, lay new 150mm concrete yard on 300mm blinded hardcore and make good to existing. Shown in yellow

New 1500mm wide concrete footpath shown shaded in green

Dropped kerb level at edge of road at entrance to the site
