1. the Minister for the Environment, Climate and Communications to enact Regulations enabled under Section 51 of the Waste Management Act 1996 (as amended) to control the addition of endocrine disrupting chemicals to agricultural land arising from the agricultural use of municipal wastewater sludge

2. and, whilst waiting for the requested Regulations, the Environment Section of Cork County Council to require both sludges and receiving soils to be analysed as required by the Code of Good Practice for the Use of Biosolids in Agriculture with all analyses recorded in the Council's Sewage Sludge Register System."
