DEVELOPMENT UNDER SECTION 179 OF THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2000 AND NOTICE PURSUANT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF PART 8, ARTICLE 81 OF THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, 2001, AS AMENDED

Notice is hereby given that Cork County Council proposes to carry out the following development:-

Ballybrack Valley Pedestrian and Cycle Route Phase 4

Location:

Berkeley Housing Estate off the Old Carrigaline Road up the valley to the N28 Carr's Hill Interchange, on through Maryborough Ridge to link to Maryborough Hill, Douglas, Co. Cork

In the Townlands of: Ardarrig, Castletreasure, Moneygurney

Nature and extent of proposed development:

The proposed development consists of circa 2.1km of a pedestrian and cycle path with ducting, public lighting and fencing.

Three Toucan crossings are proposed along with road signage, road markings and bollards. Three connection points to zoned lands are included including provision for two bridges. Three raised table crossing points are also included.

Please note that the above measures are shown graphically on the scheme drawings. A route selection report and environmental screening report also form part of this application
