### DEVELOPMENT UNDER SECTION 179 OF THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2000, AS AMENDED AND NOTICE PURSUANT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF PART 8, ARTICLE 81 OF THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS, 2001, AS AMENDED

Notice is hereby given that Cork County Council proposes to carry out the following development:-

#### **Bóthar Guidel/Church Road Improvement Works, Carrigaline**

##### **Location:**

Bóthar Guidel (R612) and Church Road (R613) in Carrigaline Middle, Carrigaline, Co. Cork.

##### **Nature and extent of proposed development:**

The Scheme includes improvements to the southern and western approaches to the junction of Bóthar Guidel and Church Road and includes the following:

- An increase in length of the right turn lane on Bóthar Guidel (i.e. southern approach to junction)
- Provision of improved 2-way cycle facilities along eastern side of Bóthar Guidel
- The provision of a right turn lane serving the Owenabue car park
- A new footpath along the northern side of Church Road
- An increase in width of the right turn lane on Church Road (i.e. western approach)

Please note that the above measures are shown graphically on the scheme drawings. An Appropriate Assessment screening report also forms part of this application.

Plans and particulars of the proposed development will be available for inspection for a period of **4 weeks**, at the following venues and times: -

- Lobby, Floor 11, County Hall, Cork between the hours of 09:00 and 17:00. The documents can be purchased for a fee of €15.00 per set at this location.
- Cork County Council Area Engineer's Office, Church Road, Carrigaline, Co. Cork between the hours of 09:00 and 17:00.

on each working day during which the said offices are opened for the transaction of business, for a period beginning on **Friday 26<sup>th</sup> April 2019** and ending on **Monday 27<sup>th</sup> May 2019**.

Submissions and observations with respect to the proposed development, dealing with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area in which the development would be situated, may be made in writing to Senior Engineer, Cork County Council, Traffic and Transportation, Floor 11, County Hall, Cork or by email to [trafficandtransport@corkcoco.ie](mailto:trafficandtransport@corkcoco.ie) , **on or before Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> June 2019**.

As per Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended), an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) screening determination has been made and a determination has been made that an **EIA is not required**. In accordance with Article 120 (3), as amended by S.I. No. 296 of 2018, a person may, within 4 weeks from the date of this notice (26<sup>th</sup> April 2019) apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment. Such a submission should be addressed to the Secretary, An Bord Pleanála, 64, Marlborough Street, Dublin, 1.
