TRADITIONAL SOLO STEP DANCING WORKSHOPS

Sarah and Maurice are Ireland's leading young traditional step-dancers continuing the tradition of the old dancing masters. They will teach the authentic old traditional step dances and explain the history behind them. Starting with the "Three Sea Captains", which goes back to the Battle of Navarino in 1827, the steps in this dance depict the movement of ships in battle. These dances have almost vanished from our tradition.
