

Submissions or Observations with respect to the proposed development, dealing with proper planning and sustainable development of the area in which the development will be situated, may be made using the **online submission form** on www.yourcouncil.ie or, in writing to **Senior Engineer, Cork County Council, Regional & Local Roads Design Office, Floor 3, County Library Building, Carrigrohane Road, Cork, T12 K335** or emailed to part8.rlrdo@corkcoco.ie and must reach the Senior Engineer **on or before 4pm on Friday 5th June 2020**.

As per Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) screening determination has been made and a determination has been made that an **EIA Report is not required**. In accordance with Article 120 (3), as amended by S.I. No. 296 of 2018, a person may, **within 4 weeks** from the date of this notice (**Friday 10th April 2020**), apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment. Such a submission should be addressed to the Secretary, An Bord Pleanála, 64, Marlborough Street, Dublin, 1.
