The extension to the public consultation period is required as a result of recently enacted emergency legislation, the Emergency Measures in the Public Interest (Covid 19) Act, 2020. Section 9 of this Act inserts Section 251A into the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended. The Minister has made an Order under Section 251A(4), such that the period from **29<sup>th</sup> March 2020 to 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2020 inclusive** may be disregarded when calculating timelines in the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended.



**Submissions or Observations** with respect to the proposed development, dealing with proper planning and sustainable development of the area in which the development will be situated, may be made using the online submission form on [www.yourcouncil.ie](http://www.yourcouncil.ie) or, in writing to **Senior Engineer, Cork County Council, Regional & Local Roads Design Office, Floor 3, County Library Building, Carrigrohane Road, Cork, T12 K335** or emailed to [part8.rlrdo@corkcoco.ie](mailto:part8.rlrdo@corkcoco.ie) and must reach the Senior Engineer on or before **4pm on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2020.**

As per Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) screening determination has been made and a determination has been made that an **EIA Report is not required.** In accordance with Article 120 (3), as amended by S.I. No. 296 of 2018, a person may until **28<sup>th</sup> June 2020** apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment. Such a submission should be addressed to the Secretary, An Bord Pleanála, 64, Marlborough Street, Dublin, 1.
