What to consider when sending your print job to the printer remotely

Once you have sent your print job you have until the next working day to collect it. <u>Exception</u>: Any print job sent on a Friday will need to be collected that day.

It can take up to 20 minutes after you have sent your job to the printer before it is ready to print from our system. Including if you have received a confirmation e-mail.

Please ensure you know the e-mail address from which the document was sent to the printer from when you arrive to collect your print job.

A4 is the smallest size a photograph will print.



Option 2: From the Browser




