23. “that Cork County Council would liaise with the HSE in relation to improving the sight distance on the Tallow side for motorists when exiting St. Patrick’s Community Hospital, Fermoy in the interest of safety of all road users, and consider a speed activated road detection sign on the Tallow side of the hospital entrance”.
