“That Council give priority to its obligations under the **Irish Human Rights and Equality Commission Act 2014**, with particular reference to Section 42 of the Act by:

1. As a matter of urgency, carry out an assessment of the Human Rights and Equality issues relevant to the Council’s functions.
2. Adopting a pro-active approach to dealing with Human Rights and Equality issues, rather than reacting after rights violations have already taken place.
3. To work with other state and voluntary agencies, in particular in the area of housing and homelessness, to ensure that Human Rights are respected and that service users (the public, vulnerable groups/communities etc.) are proactively assisted at all times.
4. Engaging with the Irish Human Rights and Equality Commission for the purpose of training both the members and staff of Council and in the development of a corporate plan for its Public Sector Duty in this area.
5. Commit to ensuring participation by organisations representing groups experiencing inequality and human rights violations in developing and implementing the plan.
6. That the CEO report back to Council on the development and rollout of such a plan, including on the reporting and monitoring requirements and engagement with the public in general.
