- 2. "That traffic calming measures would be implemented above Scart Cross, Donnybrook by College Corinthians."
- 3. "That this Municipal District would undertake a plan to develop possible rapid bus corridors, light rail lines and cycle networks within the Municipal District for future planning and that correspondence be made to the Minister for Transport of this plan, with a request for assistance."
