“That this municipal council would ensure that Ticknock hill in Cobh would be included in the resurfacing works in the district for 2018 and that the water main would be replaced to avoid the chaos of last year”

“That this municipal district would consider designating the area by Cuskinny Marsh as a special nature amenity area and efforts would be made to make this area a pedestrian and cyclist friendly area”

“That this municipal district agree a proper programme of repair work to road signs and poles and that a time scale for this work be agreed”

- b) On Great Island, in Carrigtwohill and Little Island to support a fish processing and distribution industry.
- c) On the supports available for the development of local business based on the fishing industry, and the support industries required by it.

20. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Diarmaid O’Cadhla:

“That the Municipal Council write to Cork County Council requesting:

- a) A written update on what is happening in regards to the housing needs of the two tenants at No. 4 Harbour Hill, Cobh, both of whom suffer from significant disabilities and continue to live in inhuman and dangerous conditions.
- b) Written clarification on how long is it permissible to allow tenants to live in such inhuman conditions as exist at No. 4 Harbour Hill.
- c) Whether the Council are taking legal action against the landlord of No. 4 Harbour Hill for violation of the MINIMUM STANDARDS in rental accommodation”
