“That this Municipal solve the ongoing flooding problem at the John Barleycorn Bridge (Palmgrove Estate side), and treat it as a major health and safety concern, and if necessary to apply for a road closure to solve the problem once and for all.”
- 9. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Ger Keohane:**
“That this Municipal solve the ongoing flooding outside the Marwood estate and towards Sars GAA pitch.”

- 10. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Ger Keohane:**
“That this Municipal install two speed ramps inside the Oakfield Estate adjacent to the main green area within the estate”
- 11. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Sinead Sheppard:**
“That Cobh Municipal Council would put a request forward to Irish Water in relation to fixing a new pipe or changing water source from Tibbotstown to Glashaboy for residents of Belvelly”
- 12. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Cathal Rasmussen:**
“That this municipal write to the Port of Cork and invite them to a meeting with the councillors to discuss their plans for the Marino point site in Cobh. Also to discuss any potential traffic plans that they may have in relation to the potential increase traffic on the R624”
- 13. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Cathal Rasmussen:**
“That this municipal would consider the installation of a viewing area on the right hand side of the bank in the park at West View, Cobh to facilitate the many tourists who visit the park and take photographs of Cobh Cathedral. Also that the damage done to the kerbs and path during the drainage work would be sorted out before the tourist season begins again”
- 14. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Cathal Rasmussen:**
“(a) That this municipal would do a full survey of the number and type of signposts in the town of Cobh in light of the extra new poles and signs erected recently and that we would look at standardising the type and colour of these signs.
(b) That this municipal would do a full survey of all areas of Knot weed in the municipal and that we engage with the communities to generate this full and accurate list”
- 15. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Sinead Sheppard:**
“That Cobh Municipal District would ask the Planning Department for a list of all housing estates within the Municipal District area that have not been taken in charge and enquire if a bond is still attached to any of those estates”

“Due to the heavy volumes of traffic at the junction of Castlelake and Main Street Carrigtwohill a plan to signalise or put a roundabout at this junction be put in place”

- 17. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Anthony Barry:**
“After the heavy rainfall events of recent weeks could the intolerable flooding which is a regular occurrence at Barryscourt and Main Street be addressed”
- 18. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Padraig O’Sullivan:**
“That this Municipal District would write to the Minister for Housing Planning and Local Government expressing this MD's dissatisfaction at an Bord Pleanála's "Fast Track Policy" in how it can circumvent the members Local Area Plan and breach guidelines for the amount of unit's proposed in the Local Area Plan. We consider these powers to be overbearing and anti democratic and urge the Minister to review the situation urgently”
- 19. To consider the following Notice of Motion in the name of Cllr. Padraig O’Sullivan:**
“That this MD would ask what provision is made for rehousing the elderly in to sheltered housing/retirement villages in this Local Authority. That this Municipal District would ask that provision be made for housing the elderly in communities particularly in larger developments such as those proposed in Waterrock, Carrigtwohill East and Midleton”
