The walkway has proved to be a very popular local amenity and the installing of a pathway on this small stretch would enhance its appeal as well as improve health and safety for all
- b.) To extend the footpath on the R632 from Maple Woods towards the pedestrian crossing and on towards the Bailick Road.
- c.) Update on improvements to footpath at Spittal, Cloyne, and road markings to discourage inappropriate parking on footpaths and encourage best practice by pedestrians and road users in the interests of road safety.
