Welcome & Introduction

It was noted that a quorum was in place and the meeting commenced. The meeting agreed, on the proposal of Mr. K. Curran, seconded by Ms. E. O'Shea that Cilr. Declan Hurley would take the position of chair. The Chair welcomed all to the meeting.

1. Confirmation of Minutes of the Previous LCDC Meeting of 11th April, 2019

The adoption of the minutes of the West Cork LCDC meeting of 11th April, 2019 was proposed by Mr. J. Kennedy, seconded by Mr. T. Collins and were formally adopted by the meeting.

3. Community Enhancement Programme 2019

Ms. K. Keegan advised that the Community Enhancement Programme would shortly be advertised to invite applications for 2019. The 2019 scheme is funded by the Department of Rural & Community Development with support from the Local Community Development Committees (LCDCs) of Cork County Council.

The Countywide allocation under the scheme is €160,000 with a minimum of 30% of monies being allocated to grants of €1,000 or less. There are two types of grants available under this Programme:

- Small scale capital grant up to a maximum of €1,000 or less
- Capital grant in excess of €1,000

Those areas moving to the Cork City Council administrative area will apply to the City and the closing date for both City and County Councils was put back to 28th June to facilitate the groups who would be affected by the boundary changes.

4.A.O.B

<u>Community Enhancement Programme 2018: Reallocation of remaining CEP Funds West Cork LCDC</u>

Ms. V. Hayes advised the meeting that there was a balance of €337 to be allocated as follows:

Grants not used by 3 Groups €3,099
Balance of allocation not used by Groups €6,910
Total €10,009

At the West LCDC Meeting held on 11th April, €9,672 was reallocated leaving a balance of €337.

It is proposed to allocate to the following:

Castletownshend Rowing Club was allocated €2,000 under the CEP for the purchase of 4 oars. The overall cost was €2,142.

Recommendation: allocate €142 to Castletownshend Rowing Club

Croi na Laoi Development Society was allocated €2,664 under the CEP for the purchase of a storage container. The overall cost was €2,952.

Recommendation: allocate €195 to Croi na Laoi Development Society

These recommendations were agreed by the meeting on the proposal of Mr. J. Walsh, seconded by Mr. J. Kennedy.

Correspondence from Department of Employment Affairs and Social Protection

Ms. K. Keegan read a letter from the Department of Employment Affairs and Social

Protection in response to a letter sent from the LCDCs regarding the eligibility criteria for the

Tús scheme. The Department advised that they would monitor the scheme but that there

were no plans at the moment to change the eligibility criteria.

Members were disappointed with the response from the Department as there seemed to be no recognition of the social benefit of the scheme.

The Chair reminded Members that this was the last LCDC meeting during the time of the current Council and wished all involved in the local elections the best of luck.

Ms. K. Keegan on behalf of CCC staff thanked all members for their work on the LCDC and for their commitment.

5. Date of Next Meeting

The Chair confirmed the date of the next meeting, 4th July, and thanked everyone for their attendance. The meeting concluded.
