FEBRUARY 2021 - NOTICES OF MOTIONS

Cllr. Frank O' Flynn

 "that Cork County Council put in place traffic calming measures including a soft ramp in Main Street, Glanworth in the interest of safety of all road users".

Cllr. William O' Leary

 "that this Council would list out the number of fines issued for Dog Fouling in the Fermoy Electoral area for the five year period 2015 - 2020".

Cllr. Noel McCarthy

 "that this Council install permanent lights on the clock in Pearse Square. This is an historic and highly visible part of Fermoy and lighting would add to its aesthetic and charm".

4. "that this Council provide public light in the Car Park at the entrance to TO Park in the interest of safety of persons attending events in the Community Hall".

- "that Cork County Council put in place traffic calming measures from Killavullen bridge through the village including a soft ramp in the interest of safety".
