- (a) Confirmation of minutes of meeting of Municipal District of Bandon Kinsale held on 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2019

On the proposal of Cllr. Coughlan, seconded by Cllr. Lombard the minutes of meeting held on 22nd March 2019 were agreed.

Cllr. Coughlan

- Expressed disappointment over the cancellation of Municipal Hall Development Committee delegation to meeting. MDOH said that due to time constraints and change of venue, it wasn't possible to host the deputation at this time. He also said it would be advisable for the group to send in their plan to members before meeting the members.
- Anti-social behaviour at Millbrook Hospital, can it be put on Derelict Sites Register?
  MDOH said as it wasn't on roadside, it couldn't be.

He also commented on the distance from the town centre to the proposed location. EOH said that he had liaised with the Lions Club and will revert if there is any update.

CMC informed the meeting that the RI Programme was underway and preparation work is done for surface dressing and in Kinsale works have commenced on pavements. Cllr. Lombard asked that via social media that the public be notified that Crosshaven is open for business during works. MD said that it was hoped that works would be completed before the May Bank Holiday.

(e) Municipal Officer's Report.

EOH informed members that the paint scheme for 2019 would be advertised in the coming week and that the closing date for receipt of applications would be 7<sup>th</sup> June 2019 and the successful applicants would then have four months to complete works. Priority would be given to buildings in poor condition.

On the proposal of Cllr. Coughlan, seconded by Cllr. Lombard, this was agreed.

Cllr. Coughlan pointed out that this should have been carried out during the Part 8 process. MDOH said that this was temporary works to facilitate construction works. On the proposal of Cllr. Coughlan, seconded by Cllr. Murphy, this was agreed.

(c) Section 183 Notice – Lease of Unit 7 at Carrigaline Industrial Park, Kilnagleary Road, Carrigaline, Co. Cork.

On the proposal of Cllr. Lombard, seconded by Cllr. Coughlan, this was agreed.

# (d) Notices of Motion submitted by Cllr. Aidan Lombard.

(i) that this Council apply for both the recently announced rural regeneration fund and the Town & Village Renewal Scheme for the delivery of the footpath in Minane Bridge. Both these schemes can deliver the funding required to deliver this critical piece of infrastructure.

Cllr. Lombard asked that this MD be positive and progress the applications for funding so that this project can be completed. Cllrs Coughlan and Murphy lent their support for this. MDOH said that the mentioned schemes did require an element of funding from Cork County Council and the terms of the scheme can be looked at and if appropriate can apply.

(ii) That we receive a progress report on the Ferney Road Scheme in Carrigaline.

CMC said that he had discussed this with the Roads Design Office and there was an ongoing process with landowners. Once this was done, project can proceed to tender and construction stage. No date available.
