4. Community Development Initiative 2021 - Update

The Chief Officer updated LCDC members on this scheme:

- Launched on 9th August 2021.
- Closed on 17th September 2021.
- 241 applications to a total value of €2,868,713 received.
- Fund of €750,000 available, 25% reserved for Local Development Companies for administration and animation.
- Assessment by Local Development Companies to begin on 27th September 2021.
- Evaluation by Independent Evaluation Committees to take place in November 2021.
- Approval of scheme by LCDCs to take place in December 2021.



Closing date for completion of projects and claims is 30th November 2022.

5. Social Enterprise Capital Grants Scheme 2021 - Overview

The Chief Officer updated LCDC members on the launch of this scheme:

- €1m available nationally, €43,173.51 available for Cork County.
- Provides funding for the purchase of equipment or the carrying out of repairs or refurbishments to enable social enterprises to improve their service delivery.
- Supports one of the key commitments in the National Social Enterprise Policy for Ireland 2019-2022 "Growing and Strengthening Social Enterprise".
