Welcome and Introduction.

The Chair Cllr. Cathal Rasmussen was unable to attend and Deputy Chair Cllr. Michael Hegarty was delayed. Cllr. Seamus McGrath hosted the meeting. He welcomed all to the meeting.

It was noted that a quorum was in place and the meeting commenced.

1. Confirmation of Minutes of the Previous LCDC Meeting of 16th March 2021.

The Minutes were adopted on the proposal of Mary O'Leary and seconded by Cllr. Seamus McGrath.

2. SICAP

Approval of End of Year Reports 2020 presented by Andrew Lewis

Andrew Lewis confirmed that the SICAP Subgroup had met with the Local Development Company and said that there are no performance issues that need to be addressed. He acknowledged that COVID-19 had a major impact on the companies and how they deliver the SICAP programme in 2020. He added that a significant number of community groups found 2020 very difficult due to a lack of fundraising opportunities. He clarified that despite COVID-19 the Local Development Company succeeded in supporting the vast majority of community groups and that he is very happy with their performance in 2020. He confirmed that they there were no issues with delivery on KPIs 1 and 2. He noted that the Department has been very flexible with KPIs for 2020 and 2021 in that SECAD had sought a reduction of 10% to KPI 1 and 15% to KPI 2 which had been agreed by Pobal and the Department

The End of Year Reports 2020 for Lot 18-4 was approved on the proposal of Cllr. Marcia Dalton and seconded by Sean O'Sullivan.

The approval of the Annual Plans 2021 for Lot 18-4 was proposed by Cllr. Marcia Dalton and seconded by Cllr. Seamus McGrath.

Ryan Howard requested that Pobal and the Department continue their flexibility regarding the delivery of SICAP KPIs. Arran O'Driscoll and Cllr. Seamus McGrath agreed. Andrew Lewis outlined that this flexibility has been afforded by the Department for 2020 and 2021 and that the Department has acknowledged that this flexibility is needed and is there.

Cllr. Seamus McGrath acknowledged that flexibility is there and asked that it continue. Arran O'Driscoll said that the Local Development Companies want to meet their goals and that the number of referrals coming through is rising. She said that the Local Development Companies are working to meet their KPIs.
