1. Confirmation of Minutes of the Previous LCDC Meeting of 25th February 2021

2. COVID-19 Emergency Fund 2021 presented by the Chief Officer

The national allocation of €1.7M was announced in December with Cork County 's allocation being €65,191 The Department recommended that LCDCs ring-fence 30% of funding to grants of €1,000 or less.

The fund was launched in Cork County on 18th January with a closing date of 4pm on Friday, 5th February.

All projects have until 30th July, 2021 for drawdown of monies, this includes return of receipts plus photographic evidence prior to payment being made.

Those that were unsuccessful were either too large to be funded or the project was deemed ineligible under the scheme guidelines.


