Addendum

Following the in-committee meeting of the Cobh Municipal District dated 10th June 2022, this addendum to the Part 8 Report of Chief Executive includes some additional modifications to the Part 8 planning application for the Carrigtwohill Urban Regeneration Development Fund (URDF) Initiative – Public Realm Infrastructure Bundle.

The report recommends the following proposed modifications to the application;

• **Modification 22** – The pedestrian link connecting the proposed car park (Presbytery Orchard Car Park) to the Main Street is to be moved further east.



Modification 23 – To provide access to existing driveways, vehicular crossovers will be provided at Nos.1 &
 2 Patrick Pearse Place.



Modification 24 – Provision of a pedestrian access to O'Donovan Transport from the proposed civic space.

Recommendation

Having considered the submissions and the internal reports from the Planning Department, I am satisfied that the proposed development, incorporating the recommended modifications in Section 5.2 of the Part 8 of Chief Executive together with the modifications in this addendum report, is in accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area and I recommend to the Members of the Cobh Municipal District that Cork County Council should proceed accordingly.
