We are at the preliminary stages of designing a small housing scheme on Sleaveen Road, Macroom town centre.

Site location here: <https://goo.gl/maps/4P3BSsgU91Z9iGTw9> & attached. The site area is 0.1934 Hectares (0.478 Acres).

The development comprises 16 units in total with the proposed mix being as follows:

- 7 - 2 Bed/3 Person Apartments
- 5 - 1 Bed/2 Person Apartments
- 4 - 2 Bed/4 Person Townhouses

It is our view that a Archaeological Assessment is not required as the site is less than 0.5 hectares and is located outside of the National Monuments 'Zone of Notification' as per the attached documents.
