

Dear Resident / Business,

The IRONMAN Group in association with Cork County Council bringing IRONMAN Ireland and IRONMAN 70.3 IRELAND to Youghal and surrounding areas of East Cork on 12th, 13th and 14th August 2022. The event will see over 2,500 take on the Full distance of 3.8km swim, a 180km cycle, followed by a 42.2km marathon distance run on Sunday 14th August with the IRONMAN 70.3 on Saturday 13th where they will take on a 1900m swim 90km cycle and a 21.1km run.

The event will have implications on traffic and access which are detailed overleaf in this letter and overleaf on the route and access overview. The cycle and run routes will be operated on a rolling road closure basis with full road closure in operation ( by order). Applications have been submitted to the roadworks unit in Cork County Council according to the guidelines set down for the road closure and times highlighted below. *(Please see overleaf for Sunday).*

The event organisers are working in partnership with An Garda Siochana and Cork County Council to ensure that disruption to residents and businesses along the route is kept to a minimum where possible during the event but with an event of this size there will be delays on the route and surrounding areas. We would strongly advise to avoid travel near the course route where road closures will be in place on Saturday 13th August and Sunday 14th August, 2022. As per legislative guidelines, the specific road closures for both event days will be advertised through Cork County Council as well as newspapers.
