- Previous LECP adopted in 2016 2021 as a six-year plan.
- o Undertaken by the Planning Directorate of Cork County Council.
- o Broad and ambitious plan.
- New LECP to be in place for January 2023.
- An Advisory Steering Group to be put in place
 - As per guidelines, to include: Sharon Corcoran, Director of Services; Kay Keegan, LCDC Chief Officer; the chairs of the Economic and Rural Development SPCs and; the chairs of the North, South and West Cork LCDCs.
 - o Representatives from other public/private bodies.



- New LECP is a two-part process:
- Part 1: Review previous LECP and develop high level strategic goals
 Also required to carry out a Socio-Economic Profile of Cork County, currently in the process of appointing People & Places Consultants to carry out this body of work.
- Part 2: Development of Implementation Plans, 2-3 of these required over the lifetime of the Programme, these will include activities/actions.

Draft LECP:

- A team of 2, who will report to the Director of Services, Economic Development Enterprise & Tourism is being formed to work on the new LECP
- Draft with high level goals to be approved by the corresponding Economic and Rural Development SPCs and the North, South and West Cork LCDCs – end of the summer.
- o To be put out for wide public consultation end of September.
- Revised Draft to come back to LCDCs/SPCs for adoption
- Consultation to take place with Municipal Districts/Regional Assembly Nov/Dec 2022
- Final Sign off by LCDCs/SPCs, Adoption by CCC & submitted to Minister by end of the year.

New government measures:

- KPIs must be created by Cork County Council and reported back on to the Department annually.
- Any future government funding applied for by Cork County Council must be applicable to the LECP.

Michael Doyle asked how the new LECP will feed into Cork County Council's environmental objectives. Sharon Corcoran said that the plan must be sustainable and must address climate change as part of its strategic goals.
