 - Dimensions not to be scaled from drawing. Any queries to be conveyed to the CCC Road Design Office, Innishmore, Ballincollig.
 - The location of all signs and road markings are to be agreed onsite with the Engineer prior to installation.
 - The 'dimples' or 'blisters' on the tactile paving units shall be aligned so as to guide visually impaired pedestrians directly to the other side of the crossing.
 - Tactile paving details from "Guidance on the Use of Tactile Paving Surfaces" published by the Department of the Environment, Transport and the Regions (UK) in 1998.
 - Maximum projection of dropped kerbs at tactile paving locations to be 6mm above carriageway level.
 - The location of tactile paving and associated dropped kerbs are to be agreed with the Engineer prior to installation.
