OCTOBER 2022 - NOTICES OF MOTIONS

Cllr. Noel McCarthy

1. “that this Committee would receive an Engineer’s report on the possibility of a cycle lane and footpath on the R639 from Coolcarron, Fermoy to Corrin Woods”.

2. “that Cork County Council put in place extra lighting and improve the existing lighting at Coolcairn Estate, Duntaheen, Fermoy in the interest of safety”.

3. “that this Council would consider installing an extra tap for water supply (at the back wall) in Kilcrumper new cemetery”.
