- SICAP Mid-Year Reviews

Andrew Lewis gave an overview of Mid Year Review 2022 meetings that took place with each of the three Local Development Companies (Programme Implementer) and the LCDC SICAP Sub Group members together with LCDC SICAP Support Staff.

The Mid Year Reports had been submitted on time. It was confirmed that each of the Local Development Companies had achieved satisfactory progress to date and each of the mid-year Key Performance Indicators (KPI's) have been achieved. The budgetary position of each LDC was also deemed satisfactory at this stage. The Sub Group wanted to acknowledge the significant additional workload by all three companies as a result of the Ukraine crisis.
