

LECP Background

- ► Local Government Reform Act 2014
- ► Local element of the national framework
- ► 6-year strategic plan for Cork County which promotes and supports economic & local community development
- ▶ Led by the Local Authority, economic & community stakeholders
- ► Economic and societal changes since the 1st LECP
- ► Structures such as SPCs, LEOs, PPN, and LCDCs are now firmly established at local level
- New 2 stage process = LECP high level objectives framework and Implementation Plan

LECP Stages




Structure and Purpose of the Advisory Steering Group

- ▶ One of the first steps is to establish an ASG to assist in and advise on the preparation, adoption, implementation and monitoring of the LECP
- ► To ensure an integrated plan bringing community and economic elements together
- ► Advisory Steering Group to include:
 - LCDC members
 - SPC members
 - Chief Officer LCDC
 - Director of Service EDET
 - Senior stakeholders public & private bodies

LCDC - Lead Role

- ► LECP has 2 separate but interconnected elements economic and community development
- ► The Local Government Reform Act 2014 requires the community elements are developed through the LCDCS
- ► Multiple policies to be taken on board for example Our Rural Future, Making Remote Work, Roadmap for Social Inclusion
- ► Regional elements through the Regional Spatial and Economic Strategies and Regional Enterprise Plans

Employment

- HLG 1: Provide for a wide range of employment opportunities, across the county, which enable all citizens to participate fully in society and the economy
