Welcome and Introduction

It was noted that a quorum was in place and the meeting commenced.

1. Confirmation of Minutes of the Previous LCDC Meeting of Monday 20th February 2023

The Minutes were adopted on the proposal of Cllr. Gerard Murphy and seconded by Cllr. Pat Hayes.

2. SICAP

SICAP End of Year Reviews 2022 for lots 18.1, 18.2 and 18.3

Andrew Lewis confirmed that the SICAP Sub Group had held meetings with each of the Local Development Companies to discuss the SICAP EYR 2022 performance and the Annual Plans for 2023. It was confirmed that the 3 Local Development Companies achieved KPI 1 and KPI 2 targets for year 2022. During the individual meetings with the three LDCs concerns were raised such as the prolonged impact of Covid on the programme such as the impact on children's mental health, the age profile of volunteers and the reliance on older population within communities. Another concern was the Ukrainian crisis with the migration of new members to the communities however, it was acknowledged that the coordination approach of forum members including the Local Authority, LCDC and Local Development Companies, the DEASP, and HSE has assisted greatly throughout the past year. It was noted that the anti-migrant sentiment was not as great an issue in the North Cork area compared to other areas of the Country.

Andrew thanked the members of the SICAP Sub Group which included Majella Murphy, Cllr. Gearóid Murphy & Cllr. Gerard Murphy.

Both the Chairman & Vice Chairman stood in for Declan O'Leary & Geraldine Canning (who has retired in past month)

The Chair thanked Andrew and the SICAP Sub Group for their work on the SICAP End of the Year Review for 2022 & Annual Plan for 2023.

Sean Hegarty reiterated the fact that it is not easy to bring in new volunteers and that a new strategy was required to address both the age profile & gender balance of all community groups.

Cllr. Gerard Murphy concurred with Andrew Lewis that the programme carried out went extremely well, that getting people involved is extremely important, and suggested that one area to target is the schools.
