3. 2023 Community Recognition Fund (Ukraine Fund) – Update

Minister Heather Humphries, Dept of Rural & Community Development (DRCD) launched this scheme in February 2023. An allocation of €2.307m was awarded to Cork County Council. The Council was asked to invite Expressions of Interest (EOI) from communities with Ukrainians for projects within their community. As a result of this EOI process, the Council submitted approx 90 projects to DRCD on 15th March 2023 for consideration. Last week, DRCD approved these projects and below is a list of the 11 successful projects within Macroom Municipal District totalling an overall award of €334,500 for this District:


5. 2023 Paint Scheme

Tenants or owners of buildings can avail of a grant of up to 50% of the cost of works, up to a maximum of &800.00 for works carried out by a contractor. A contribution to a maximum of 100% or &800.00, whichever is the lesser, may be paid towards the cost of materials where it is proposed the tenant/owner will undertake the works themselves.

6. Millstreet Age Friendly Committee - Update

Following the walkability study by Millstreet Age Friendly Committee a number of projects have been agreed to be progressed for implementation. This group is also working closely with the Millstreet Town Park Committee to develop age friendly projects in the town park with additional age friendly seating & car parking under consideration.

A 2^{nd} age friendly car parking space was completed on Main Street by Reen's Pharmacy.

Additional age friendly parking is being considered for the Square & at Carnegie Hall car park. An Age Friendly leaflet with location information being devised and regular future updates also being considered. Information to be shared with local website

Further updates on the future projects will issue in the coming months. This Committee meet monthly to progress their projects. They are also engaging with local businesses to promote age friendly initiatives in their stores.
