Cllr. Frank O' Flynn

1. "that Cork County Council in the interest of safety would put in place advanced signage on the R512 and the adjoining L5618 and L5638 roads approaching Charlie Burkes Cross, Glanworth as this is both a school bus and Local Link bus pick up point".

2. "call on Cork County Council to trim grass edges of the footpaths on the ring road in Mitchelstown. The grass has encroached onto path and is making it difficult for walkers".

3. "that this Committee write to the HSE with reference to improving visibility on exiting Fermoy Hospital".
