"Restating Council's call in 2014 and again in 2018 for an end to the fluoridation of drinking water and emphasising Council's particular concerns with regard to:

- the neurotoxicity of fluoride and in particular recent international studies linking an IQ loss in children from prenatal exposure to fluoride from water fluoridation
- increasing awareness of the synergistic effect of toxins on the human body and the environment
- increasing focus on the ethics of protecting susceptible sub-populations.

In responding to the above, this Council requests that the Department of Health (who is responsible for implementing the policy of fluoridation established under Statute) would outline:

- any investigative studies or reviews carried out on the interaction between fluoride (as added to public drinking water supplies) and other common toxins
- any ethical evaluation of the impact of mass medication on sub-populations especially negatively affected by fluoride (as added to public drinking water supplies)
- its new model for fluoridation monitoring following the disbanding of the Irish Expert Body on Fluorides and Health in 2022."

"That this Council call on the Government to outline its policy on the sourcing of accommodation for International Protection Applicants i.e. type of accommodation considered, the process for obtaining a fire inspection safety certificate; discontentment, division is rising in many of our communities and rural areas as there is feeling of huge unfair burden of unknown placed on them without the adequate resources, services and communications."
