We have completed the review of the Pre-Connection Enquiry.

Irish Water has reviewed the pre-connection enquiry in relation to a Water & Wastewater connection for a Housing Development of 26 unit(s) at Old Coach Avenue, Millstreet, Co. Cork **(the Development)**.

Based upon the details provided we can advise the following regarding connecting to the networks;

Feasible Subject to upgrades: Water Connection In order to accommodate the proposed connection, approximately 45m of water network upgrades will be required to provide additional network capacity. Irish Water does not currently have any plans to undertake these works, therefore the applicant will be required to fund these local network upgrades. The fee for these works will be calculated at a connection application stage. Wastewater -Feasible Subject to upgrades: Connection In order to accommodate the proposed connection, approximately 105m of wastewater network upgrades will be required to provide additional network capacity. Irish Water does not currently have any plans to undertake these works, therefore the applicant will be required to fund these local network upgrades. The fee for these works will be calculated at a connection application stage.
