Direction in the matter of Section 31 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended)

TAKE NOTICE THAT:

On 22nd December 2014, the Minister for the Environment, Community and Local Government notified Cork County Council of his intent to issue a Direction pursuant to Section 31 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended). The draft Ministerial Direction related to the County Cork Development Plan 2014 and Objective ZU 3-7 Appropriate Uses in Industrial Areas.

The Minster having considered the Chief Executives Report and recommendations has decided (i) that no material amendment to the draft direction is required, and (ii) that further investigation is not necessary in order to clarify any aspect of the report or submissions.

Therefore on the 4th March2015 the Minister issued a Direction pursuant to Section 31(16) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as amended). The Direction issued by the Minister under Section 31(16) is deemed to have immediate effect and its terms are considered to be incorporated into the plan from that date.

The Direction may be cited as the Planning and Development (County Cork Development Plan 2014) Direction 2015.
