***Applicants must furnish documentation to verify that they are engaged in agricultural activities on the parcel of land accessed by the road project e.g. a herd/flock number and a copy of the maps associated with their Basic Payment Income Support for Sustainability Scheme provided by the Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine, or equivalent / alternative documentary evidence. This documentation must be dated within the last 12 months.*

****Where the occupier of the land is not the registered owner, the occupier should (a) provide a copy of the Lease Agreement in place for the land in question, together with (b) confirmation of the consent of the registered owner (or beneficial owner in the event that the registered owner is deceased) to this Application.*
