Teorainn luais reatha (KPH): 100km/u

Luasteorainn shealadach le cur i bhfeidhm (KPH): 60km/u

Suíomh ina mbeidh feidhm ag an luasteorainn shealadach:

Láthair an Bhóthair – N71 Bóthar Ghlaislinne idir Droichead na Bandan agus Inis Eonáin, Co. Chorcaí.

Luasteorainn shealadach de 60km/u a thabhairt isteach sa dá threo den N71 ón gComhartha Luasteorainneacha 60/100km/u atá ann cheana féin ag an mbealach isteach go Baile Dhroichead na Bandan go pointe timpeall 2.9km soir ag Cora an Iúir (ó hOirlíne 550541, Tuaidhlíne 555922 go dtí Oirlíne 552595, Tuaidhlíne 557478).

An tréimhse a mbeidh feidhm ag an luasteorainn shealadach ina leith: Ón Luan 1 Iúil, 2024 go dtí Dé Máirt 31 Nollaig, 2024 nó cibé dáta níos luaithe a chinnfidh Comhairle Contae Chorcaí.

Is é cuspóir an luasteorainn shealadach ná sábháilteacht oibríthe bóthair agus tráchta a éascú le linn na n-oibreacha ar Thionscadal Taisteal Gníomhach Sínte N71 Bóthar Ghlaislinne / Siúlán Chlár Ní Laoire.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 2004

ROAD WORKS SPEED LIMIT ORDER – County Cork N71 Glaslinn Road / Clare O’Leary Walk Active Travel Extension Project

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 10 of the Road Traffic Act 2004, as amended, and in the interests of road safety, Cork County Council has made a Road Works Speed Limit Order as detailed below:

Existing speed limit (KPH): 100km/h

Temporary speed limit to apply (KPH): 60km/h.

Location where temporary speed limit is to apply:

Road Location – N71 Glaslinn Road between Bandon and Innishannon, Co. Cork.

The introduction of a temporary speed limit of 60km/h in both directions of the N71 from the existing 60/100km/h Speed Limit Sign at the approach to Bandon Town to a point approximately 2.9km East at Curranure (from Easting 550541, Northing 555922 to Easting 552595, Northing 557478).

Period for which temporary speed limit will apply:

From **Monday 1st July 2024 to Tuesday 31st December 2024** or such earlier date as may be determined by Cork County Council.

The purpose of the temporary speed limit is to facilitate the safety of roadworkers and traffic during the duration of works on the N71 Glaslinn Road / Clare O’Leary Walk Active Travel Extension Project.
