Councillor Ted Lucey

(a) New Wastewater Pipe in Macroom Town – Update

M. Murphy, SEO confirmed that there was no update. Cllr. Lucey stressed that this was very urgent and a response is needed from Uisce Éireann as soon as possible, he said the resurfacing works were progressing in the town and it was vital that the pipe works should be carried out at the same time as these works.

In response to Cllr. Moynihan regarding the drawings for the proposed footpath, P. Lehane, AE confirmed that J. Dwyer, SEE has received a copy of them from TII.

(b) <u>Baile Bhuirne – Bring Site removed from Church Yard – Can they be located elsewhere</u> M. O'Leary, MDO confirmed there was no update.

 P. O'Sullivan, EE circulated the results of the recent Speed Survey undertaken. He outlined that speed through this area was high, 69% of traffic exceeded the speed limit of 50 km/h. In response to Cllr. Moynihan's query on potential mitigating measures, P. O' Sullivan, EE said that while funding was an issue, signage could be added. In response to Cllr. Moynihan's suggestion regarding installing ramps, P. O'Sullivan, EE said again funding was the issue but also there are a lot of houses on this road, and therefore they wouldn't be an ideal solution. Cllr. Creed said that as there is a haulage company nearby frequently using this road, he wouldn't be in favour of installing ramps. P. O'Sullivan, EE said he would have a look at adding additional signage and refreshing road markings. Cllr. Moynihan said she will continue to make the case for ramps to be installed.
