

CORK COUNTY COUNCIL
ROADS ACT, 1993
TEMPORARY CLOSING OF PUBLIC ROADS

Pursuant to Section 75 of the Roads Act 1993, & Article 12 of the Roads Regulations 1994, notice is hereby given that Cork County Council proposes to temporarily close the following road for the period and reason specified below:-

Road Subject of Proposed Closure

L5530-0 Chapel Cross to Aglish Cross, Ballyhea

Period of Proposed Closure

From 08.00hrs on Wednesday 11th March 2020 to 18.00hrs Friday 13th March 2020
(Daily Closure)

Reason for Proposed Closure

To facilitate **ESB Cable Pulling**

Alternative Routes

Diversion will be via L5529-16 north from Aglish Cross to Argnageehy Cross, turn right onto L1307-39 at this junction and continue along the L1324-0 until the Lidl Depot Cross and the N20. Turn right onto N20 and continue to Ballyhea village. End of diversion.

Traffic approaching from N20 are to continue onto Ballyhea Cross and follow diversions along L1324 until junction with L5529-16. Then take a left and continue to junction with L5530. End of diversion.

Local access is to be given to residents and businesses along this road closure.

Objections to this proposed temporary road closure should be made **in writing**, to the undersigned, **quoting Ref: TRC-25-2020, not later than 5pm on Tuesday 18th February, 2020**. Telephone contact details should be included in the objection.
